



## CRCXXXIII Committee Report May 24, 2020

- **CRCXXXIII Chair Activities**

- Attended the BOD meeting via Zoom and provided a written report for CRCXXXIII, as it relates to the planning efforts leading up to CRCXXXIII Convention.
- Met several times with the EC members to ensure unity in our planning efforts.
- Continued to meet regularly via telephone and/or Zoom with all Committee Chairs to offer support and assistance as needed.
- Participated in several Zoom trial run meetings (training) in preparation for our Spring Fling Zoom Speaker/Dance fundraiser.

- **CRCXXXIII Committee meeting via Zoom on May 17<sup>th</sup> via Zoom**

- All Committee Chairs provided a written report, summarized below:
- **Programming**, worked in collaboration with F&E on the "Spring Fling Zoom Speaker/Dance." There were two speakers, one local and one out of town. Our primary purpose was accomplished, the message of recovery was carried. Programming Committee continues to encourage members interested in speaking at CRCXXXIII to submit tapes.
- **F&E**, hosted "Spring Fling Zoom Speaker/Dance" on Friday, May 15<sup>th</sup>. There were a few minor glitches, which was to be expected (as we continue to practice, we learn). In both the meeting and dance we averaged about 80 people throughout the night and we raised **\$273** in donations. The feedback from attendees has been great! F&E currently, has two upcoming scheduled events Pantomime Contest/w Raffle on Friday, June 26<sup>th</sup> and All White Fashion Show/w Raffle on Friday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, (***The Flyers will be available later this week.***)
- **Registration**, the bundle package that Registration proposed is currently on hold until we have further guidelines from the hotel. Registration Committee is looking for suggestions to promote registration sells. Additionally, the Committee is currently looking at quotes to purchase mask to sell as a fundraising effort.
- **DGC**, continues to update the website and create flyers as needed.
- **Serenity Keepers** have flyers and sign-up sheets circulating, as they continue to solicit members to join. They currently have fifteen members that have signed up.
- The theme for CRCXXXIII is "**The Journey Continues, The Mask Must Go.**" The logo will be created and voted upon at our June 21<sup>st</sup> meeting.
- Additionally, we have not received any additional information from the hotel. We are still waiting on the State of Illinois to provide SOP for the convention. We will be contacting the hotel before the deadline of July 15<sup>th</sup> to reduce the contractual room block from 790 to at least

711 of which we will still be responsible to book 80% which is at 564, in order to receive comp rooms (Keith C. will continue to keep us abreast).
