

CRSC Regional Delegate Team (RDT) Report June 28, 2020

ASC Visits

As a result of the ongoing pandemic, scheduling of in-person ASC visits has been put on indefinite hold.

World Service Conference (WSC)

As a follow up of part one of the WSC was conducted virtually in twelve, two-hour sessions spread over 10 days from April 24 through May 3, 2020. Early this month, Regional and Zonal Delegates were asked to respond to an E-poll to determine next steps in the 2020 WSC process. Results of the E-poll indicates that part two of the virtual WSC will address seven CAR motions (2, 5, 9, 10, 12, 15, and 34*) and six CAT motions (26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31).

A Conference Participants (CP) webinar was held yesterday (June 27th) to discuss next steps in completing as much of the WSC business as possible and to receive an update from NAWS. It was decided that the virtual WSC will continue with multiple sessions set for August 7, 8, and 9, 2020. Additional sessions, if needed, will be held on August 28, 29, and 30, 2020. In addition, some decisions will be made by way of e-polling following these sessions. The RD and RDA will continue to represent the Chicagoland Region during the coming CP webinar and virtual WSC 2020 sessions.
